

Bill Number: **HR014-101**

Issue: No political parties or political alliances

Sponsors: Rep. Brandon Adeshakin

Intent of the Bill: The purpose of this bill are to:

1. Promote unity with our government and people
2. Let politicians make their own decisions without pressure
3. Preventing citizens from choosing a party
4. Let politicians create their own views on issues

Letter of the Bill: Be it enacted that:

1. Eliminate all political parties and alliances in our
2. government, at every level of government. A violation of this
3. law would result in the punishment of being removed from office
4. and a minimum of 10 years in jail. There would also be a fine of
5. 1 million dollars, if there is a violation of this law. This law would
6. be ran by the Judicial Branch because the Judicial Branch has
7. no parties and is the most equal and non-biased branch. The
8. Judicial Branch also interprets laws so they would be best fit to
9. interpret and enforce this law. It would benefit our society
10. because it would bring unity to our government and people. It
11. would also let politicians make their own decisions without
12. having to worry about other politicians and/or parties punishing
13. them or forcing them out of congress. This bill, if established
14. into a law, would also eliminate the need for citizens of the
15. United States of America to choose a political party. There
16. would be no costs to the creation and establishment of this bill,
17. there would just be a shift in our elections and political offices.
18. Since there would be a fine to the violation of this law, the funds

19. generated by the fine would go to the department to help the
20. United States of America pay off the debt of 17 trillion dollars.
21. If this bill is established then it will go into affect on the new
22. year, December 31st, at midnight.
